KEY TASKS



- Undertake a needs assessment of one of the 10 municipalities to analyse the knowledge gaps and identify the opportunities and challenges for both the municipality and the staff in the targeted municipalities including the municipal board
- Formulate capacity building responses which will include the development of long-term strategies for continued learning and applied skills in the selected municipalities
- Roll-out and/or deliver capacity building programmes for planning, investment,
 value chain and municipal management in the municipality
- Support the evaluation of the changes in institutional performance resulting from the abovementioned interventions.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS



- Evidence of working with government at national or sub-national level
- Summary statement indicating core competence of the individual or firm; (max 3 pages)
- List of similar assignments successfully completed in the last three (3) consecutive years; (max 3 pages)
- Names and contact details of at least three (3) clients in respect of similar projects delivered in the last 3 years for reference checking purposes;
- If the consultancy is a firm then provide names and CVs of key experts;
 (max 7 CVs, each up to 3 pages long); and
- Any other detail which will enable us to assess the relevant experience of the individual or firm, such as: copy of tax compliance certificate, copy of the registration certificate, short company brochure, etc.
